Patient Billing Information Sheet

To prepare for your visit:

- Medicaid** Please bring your card with you to each visit.
- Medicare** Please bring your card with you to each visit. You will be billed for any co-insurance after Medicare and any secondary payers have paid their portion of the claims. Sliding fee discounts will be applied to the co-insurance balance at this time.
- Insurance** Please bring your card with you to each visit. Co-payments, if you have any, are expected **at the time of the visit** (upon check-in), so please be sure to bring cash, check or credit card with you.

Sliding Fee Discount

- The Financial Assistance Card (sliding fee scale) is available to those individuals who qualify based on income. Information we need to consider you for eligibility include: the financial assistance application, four weeks of recent pay stubs for each working family member in your household, and proof of any other income or benefits received by any family member in your household (Social Security, disability, worker's compensation, alimony, child support, TANF, etc.). If you are self-employed, a copy of your most recent tax return (Schedule C) will be necessary to process your application.
- Until the application and necessary documents are received, you will be expected to pay full fee for the services rendered at Lamprey Health Care. If you qualify, you will then be issued a Financial Assistance Card and a discount (100%, 70% or 35%) will be applied to all charges incurred at Lamprey Health Care. **There will be a \$15 per visit co-pay if you qualify for full financial assistance.**
- This financial assistance also covers our prenatal program. The co-pay for prenatal visits will be \$20 for each visit. All co-pays are expected at time of each visit.
- The Financial Assistance Card covers services offered by Lamprey Health Care and is NOT an insurance card. Patients requiring labs, ultrasounds and other diagnostic or medical services at other facilities need to fill out the financial assistance application at those organizations.
- If you are unable to pay for services at the time of the visit, you will be sent a bill for any unpaid balance.

Self-Pay Patients

- Payment for services is expected at the time of the visit. Please be sure to bring cash, check or a credit card with you. **A minimum payment of \$55 is due prior to the visit.** Non-acute visits may be rescheduled if the minimum payment is not received.
- If you are unable to pay in full for services at the time of the visit, you will be sent a bill.
